Dear Renter,

We are delighted to welcome you to our Butternut cabins for your 2018 vacation in the north woods.

Our cabins are completely furnished with the exception of sheets, towels and paper products, which you must provide. Pillows, mattress pads, comforters and blankets are provided.

The Walleye has one queen size bed, two full size beds in the loft, a full and a single futon in the main room.

The Smallmouth and Perch cabins each have one full size bed and one twin.

The Bluegill has a full size bed and a bunk bed (two twins).

All cabins have their own fully equipped kitchen. Coffee makers have filters provided.

All cabins have alarm clocks, fans, heaters, a radio/cd player, picnic table, grill, lanterns, blankets, comforters and pillows. The Walleye, Smallmouth and Bluegill have DVD players. The Walleye's TV receives NBC and a sports channel only. There is no TV reception in the Smallmouth or Bluegill.

The four cabins share one raft, two piers, two fire pits, two hammocks, a canoe, a few basic bikes, a paddleboat and water toys.

There are three, 14-foot aluminum boats available. Oars, life jackets and anchors are provided. Motor rentals are nearby.

There is a fish-cleaning shack with running water and an electrical outlet near the shore to recharge boat batteries. Extra long extension cords are available in the Walleye or in the renters' shed located between the Smallmouth and the Bluegill. Campfire firewood is there for the gathering in the woods. You can also buy \$5.00 bundles of firewood just down the road at roadside stands and at the dump.

Help yourself to basic renter equipment in the shed between the Smallmouth and Bluegill. The shed is unlocked for your convenience. PLEASE RETURN ITEMS TO THE SHED BEFORE DEPARTURE UPON CHECKOUT

- **Check-in time is 2PM. Check-out is 9AM.** Your cabin will be open and the key will be inside.
- We allow pets but they must be kept on a leash for the protection of children, other guests and neighbors. **Please keep your pet off the furniture.**
- Dennis Bula is our handyman on call. He lives year round just down the road on Knapp right before Four Duck Lake Lane. Dennis' address is 11106 Knapp Rd. If you experience any problems please call him at 715-479-4706, or stop at his house. Dennis will check in periodically.
- There is a telephone in the Walleye for Walleye renter local use only. Walleye renters, please bring your own long-distance phone card for long-distance calls. The phone number in the Walleye is 715-479-4061.
- There are games, puzzles and extra supplies, for all, (light bulbs, candles, etc.) in the Walleye.
